Auction Rules

Silent Auction

Each bidder will receive a bid number on their auction program that must be used for the silent and live auction.

A bid sheet is displayed with each item in the silent auction. Enter your bid by writing your bid number and bid amount on the next available line on the bid sheet. Minimum bid and bid increments as noted on the bid sheets must be honored. Once your bid is entered, it may not be removed. All bid sheets must remain on the table until the close of that table.

Any bid without a bid number, minimum bid or improper bid increase will be disqualified.

Silent auction tables will be closing starting at 7:30 p.m. The highest bid at closing for that table is the winner. The winning bid will be circled in red. Auction chairpersons will have sole and final discretion in determining the winning bid in the event of a discrepancy.

Live Auction

The Live Auction will occur after dinner. Bids are made by raising your bid number (located on the back of your auction program) so the auctioneer recognizes it. "SOLD" spoken by the auctioneer indicates the winning bidder who is then obligated to pay the bid price.

Check Out Procedure

ALL AUCTION ITEMS MUST BE PICKED UP AND PAID FOR ON THE NIGHT OF THE AUCTION BEFORE LEAVING.

Check out will open approximately 30 minutes following the close of the Live Auction. Payment for all items can be made by check, cash or MasterCard/Visa.

An item can only be invoiced to one bid number. Therefore, for items purchased by a group, the winning bidder must present payment in one of the following ways:

- 1) The winning bidder pays in full and is reimbursed by friends/family at their convenience.
- 2) The winning bidder collects checks or cash totaling the full amount of the winning bid and presents payment at the time the invoice is closed for that item.

General Rules

All items are sold "as is". *Pathways of Promise* assumes no responsibility for the authenticity or description of any item, or for discrepancies in redeeming items from donors. The tax-deductible portion of amounts paid by auction bidders is limited to the excess over the fair market values of the goods and services purchased.

The History of Pathways of Promise

In May of 2007, Glenn and Colleen McWilliams received news that their beautiful 3-month old twins were diagnosed with Spinal Muscular Atrophy (SMA), a genetic degenerative neuromuscular condition. Almost immediately after the diagnosis, Glenn and Colleen began work to develop a regional organization dedicated to supporting the nationally-based Families of Spinal Muscular Atrophy (FSMA*).

Our work began in July of 2008 when Glenn and Colleen met a contingent of Bay Area parents and children affected by Spinal Muscular Atrophy, whose incredibly successful Concert for a Cure, helped raise funds to support FSMA. Concert for a Cure organizers generously shared all their materials and the search began for volunteers in the Sacramento region.

Meri Stratton-Phelps and Carrie Manriquez, both families who have children affected by SMA, joined the effort immediately. Since then, our numbers have continued to grow into a strong group of dedicated volunteers.

* FSMA was founded in 1984 by a small group of families determined to find a cure and treatment for spinal muscular atrophy. Since that time, FSMA has grown to become the primary fundraising organization for SMA, and to date has raised over \$43 million dollars to fund research, and to provide essential support and services for families affected by SMA.

Ryan's Story



Ryan

Ryan is an amazing 9 year old boy with Type 2 SMA.

As an infant, Ryan appeared to be perfectly healthy, reaching milestones such as rolling over and crawling. At about ten months old, Ryan's parents, Carrie and Tom, noticed that he was starting to crawl funny so Ryan was referred to a pediatric neurologist. After several weeks of tests and observations, doctors told the Manriquez family that their son indeed had a rare condition known as SMA Type 2. With this diagnosis, Ryan would not learn to stand or walk. He would never run or be able to play Little League or soccer like other children. He would be confined to a power chair, would lose ability and strength over time, and his life would ultimately be cut short when the muscles that helped him breathe no longer functioned.

Since his diagnosis, Ryan proves that life with SMA can still be wonderful. Ryan maneuvers his wheelchairs with ease, and even takes them on the ramps at the local skate parks. Ryan has become an accomplished power chair soccer player, and he has also enjoyed skiing at Alpine Meadows' adaptive ski program. At school, he joins his classmates in playing four-square, dodge ball or kickball, and his friends all find ways to include him. In the summer, Ryan is a fish and seems to be in the pool all day where it is easier for him to move, and where he can actually "walk" in the pool. Ryan is a huge fan of the Chargers, and was fortunate enough to get to go on the field pre-game in 2007 where he met and played catch with hall of fame QB Steve Young and his son!

Ryan excels in school, is extremely social and well-liked by his peers, and he always looks at the bright side of life. He often tells his parents about the things he CAN do in his wheelchair rather than focusing on what he can't do. He has plans for the future to become a police officer or a professional poker player. His parents have no doubt that Ryan will find a way to accomplish all that he can dream of. Please give generously so that research for a treatment or cure can continue, and so Ryan and others with SMA can continue to reach their dreams.

Aaron's Story

On January 24, 2008 Robert and Meri welcomed their son, into the world 3 weeks early. Aaron was perfect. Over the first 2 months they got to know their little boy, and fell more in love with him each day. During his 2 month well child check, Aaron's pediatrician commented that Aaron was not moving as much as he should, and recommended that he be evaluated by a pediatric neurologist. Aaron had already met his developmental milestones in many areas, and a referral to a physical therapist was all that was expected.

The neurologist's examination showed that Aaron did not have normal reflexes, movement or strength. A list of potential diseases was mentioned. Spinal muscular atrophy (SMA), the most devastating disease of all, was reported at the top of the list. Their world was forever changed on May 21 when the results of the genetic test came back positive for type I SMA. When Robert and Meri asked Aaron's doctors what they could do for their little boy, they were instructed to feed him, sing to him, and to love him for the time they had left. Aaron was given less 2 years to live.

The day after they learned about SMA, Robert and Meri began searching for treatments, and for hope. They located SMA specialists at the University of Utah and Stanford University, they began a structured program of physical and respiratory therapy for Aaron, and ensured they would be able to give Aaron as normal of a life as possible.

This year Aaron celebrated his second birthday, a huge milestone for a child with type I SMA. Aaron is a happy, healthy, and thriving little boy. He has traveled to Oregon, Utah, and has visited San Diego twice. Aaron loves books, animals, and being in the water. He is brave, bright, and full of love. Aaron's continued good health, and relative strength are attributed to God's good graces, the love and prayers from family and friends, a large team of experienced medical personnel, and parents who are devoted to Aaron's care.

Robert and Meri know that great things await Aaron in the future and are anxiously awaiting the day when a cure is found for SMA.


